

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Lions and Tigers

Lions and Tigers have been busy working on developing fine motor skills, exploring different mark making tools, using tweezers, threading and using scissors. Fine motor skills involve small muscles working with the brain and nervous system to control movements in areas such as the hands, fingers, lips, tongue and eyes. Developing fine motor skills helps children do things like eating, writing, manipulating objects and getting dressed.

This term the children have been focused on construction, building with a wider range of materials and resources. To support creative ideas and mark making, we have added opportunities of being creative using mark making tools to different areas of the room. This has been successful and the children have created great marks, giving meaning to their marks.

World Nursery Rhyme week was fantastic! Learning nursery rhymes using different methods and the children took a great interest in the life cycle of frogs!

Over this term with have been building a partnership with Warwickshire Libraries. The library bus has been visiting us every 3 weeks on a Wednesday and Stratford Library gave us the opportunity to create a Christmas display, which you can see in the children's area. Make sure you take a visit to the library to have a look!

We have been invited by Ellie at the Library to go and see the display and have story time Tuesday 6th December 2022.
