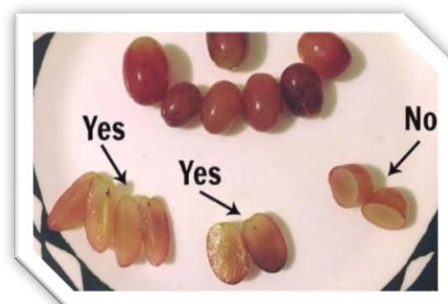

As we come to the end of a busy and exciting summer term, we would like to take a moment to reflect on the wonderful experiences the children have enjoyed over the past few weeks.

Safety has been a key focus this term. The children have learned about road safety, body awareness, and online safety, helping them to understand how to stay safe in different situations through fun and age-appropriate activities.

One of the highlights of the term was our visit from a dentist, where the children learned how to look after their teeth and keep them healthy. They also enjoyed singing, playing music, and exploring different sounds with our musician, Franc.
